The exam is offered twice a year, usually in February and August. The Massachusetts Landscape and Nursery Resource Guide and MCH Manual is required preparation to sit for the exam.

The cost for the manual is \$104 for members and \$154 for non-members Pricing includes shipping & handling.

The exam fee is separate and the cost is: \$65 for members and \$95 for non-members.

MCH is a program of the Massachusetts Nursery and Landscape Association and overseen by the Massachusetts Certified Horticulturist Board.

As a landscape contractor, retail or wholesale nursery, grounds maintenance service or landscape designer, the MCH program gives you the ability to quickly and definitively show prospective customers that you have qualified staff and you are a qualified, professional company.

Benefits to Individuals:

As an employee or an business owner in the Green Industry it is your responsibility to represent that industry in a professional manner. How do I become an MCH?

The Massachusetts Landscape and Nursery Resource Guide and MCH Manual is required preparation to sit for the exam. The self study program is centered around an exam based on the Resource Guide and covers most aspects of the nursery, landscape, grounds maintenance, and garden center industries. The exam consists of two parts: 150 multiple choice questions and the second part is plant identification. A passing grade of 70% or above is required on each exam section.

Program Requirements:

The program requires that you have 3 years full-time employment in the industry (or 2 years with an associate's degree or higher in horticulture or a related field). Yearly re-certification is required and during that period you must earn 8 credits towards recertification.
